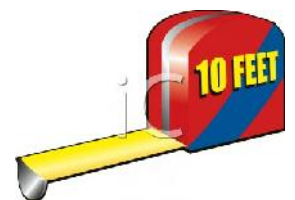

Lunch will be available each day between 11-12:30pm. Lunch will be \$5 for the meal, and volunteers will get one ticket worth \$2 for lunch for each day you work. We will hold food for volunteers in the ring! Saturday lunch will be from Holy Cannoli (pasta dishes, chicken fettuccini alfredo, eggplant parmesan and salad), and on Sunday we will have pizza, finger sandwiches, and salad. Yum!

No food (human or dog) is allowed on the turf. Please treat your dogs only on mats at entry and exit areas of the ring, or in your dog's crate. All human competitors must eat in the lobby area only.

Bait and toys must be at least ten feet from the ring. DO NOT leave your bait and bait bags on the gate steward's tables at either end of the ring or on the scoring table. Use the "bait basket" provided just outside the gates.



All exhibitors must pick up after their dogs. Dogs **cannot** be pottied near the building or entrance, please **only** use the area across the parking lot near the dumpster and along that side of the parking lot. We will have receptacles set up for the baggies.

Dogs can only enter and exit through the lobby area (please be aware of your dog and others entering and exiting). The other doors are emergency exits only.

You must have a sturdy rug or mat under all crates and chairs.

We cannot get into the venue until 6:00am on Saturday, so unfortunately there will be no run thrus. Since we will be tight on time as we can't set up until 6:00am, we would appreciate all the help we can get so we can start the trial on time. Many hands make light work!

If you are working ring set-up (**set up begins at 6am Saturday**), you may bring your rugs, crates, and dogs into the facility before helping with set-up to avoid leaving them in the cold. For all others, you may enter the facility at **7:30am** to set up your crates, chairs, etc. on Saturday. Please do not come into the facility before 7:30am unless you are coming in to help set-up.

Due to the high volume of snow received this winter, parking will be somewhat limited. It is anticipated that we will need to “double park” vehicles in order to accommodate everyone. There will be EMAC parking attendants to assist you. Just let them know if you anticipate that you'll have to leave early so they can make sure you can leave. Thanks for your understanding!
