We will also need help with setup and break-down. Setup will be Thursday morning at 10:00 for the fencing, tables and signage and at 1:00 for the equipment setup in the ring. Any and all help will be greatly appreciated! Don't forget to ask for tickets for the raffle if you are helping with either or both setup shifts! The setup and breakdown raffle will be drawn after the trailer is packed on Sunday.



Bait and toys must be at least ten feet from the ring. DO NOT leave your bait and bait bags on the gate steward's tables at either end of the ring or on the scoring table. Use the "bait hooks" provided just outside the gates. Also, please remember that all exhibitors must pick up after their dogs.

Fun Runs are being held on Thursday evening from 4pm – 6pm. All are welcome. You do not need to be registered with CPE to participate although your dog should have some experience on the equipment – for your safety and your dogs.

Breakfast and lunch are available for purchase each day, catered by Tara-bly Good Catering. Volunteers will receive a \$2 coupon/per day to use towards food. Yum!
